GRADE 6 MATH BOOST CAMP



(60 hours)

2 week Math Boost Camp from July 3 – July 14, 2017 (9am – 4pm)

The camp is intended for students who are experiencing difficulties in mathematics. Students **must** have a minimum final mark of **50%**. A referral from one's elementary school principal is a prerequisite.

Students who register for this course will participate in 30 hours of mathematics to prepare them for grade 7. The focus will be on improving basic skills and competency through hands-on activities with experienced math teachers. In addition, students will take part in 30 hours of multi-sport recreational activities.

REGISTRATION: Registration form and payment must be sent to R.S.B. by **May 22, 2017**

COST: \$325.00 per course for students who attended R.S.B. schools
\$425.00 for outside candidates (if space available)
Supplementary fees may apply should Daycare services be needed

SECONDARY REMEDIAL SESSIONS – SECONDARY I, II & SECONDARY III

(45 hours)

3 week course from **July 10 – July 28, 2017**

(8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. or 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m – determined by summer school)

Students **must** have a minimum final mark of **50%**. A student may register for a maximum of 2 courses as long as there is no time conflict.

CULTURE, SOCIAL & TECHNICAL MATHEMATICS 414

4 week course from **June 26 – July 21, 2017** (Time to Be Determined)

This four week course is specifically designed for students who require Secondary IV math in order to obtain their High School Diploma, or be promoted to Secondary V mathematics. Successful completion of Math 306 is a prerequisite.

SPECIAL 3 WEEK SCIENCE OF THE ENVIRONMENT 402

3 week course from July 3 – July 21, 2017 (Afternoon Course - Time to be confirmed)

This three week course is designed for students who have successfully completed Science & Technology 444/Applied Science & Technology 416 and wish to bridge into Chemistry 404 and/or Physics 404. This course is also geared to students who need Science of the Environment 402 as a prerequisite for entry into CEGEP programs.

SPECIAL 4 WEEK SCIENTIFIC MATH 426 COURSE

4 week course from **June 26 – July 21, 2017** (8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.)

This four week course is designed for students who have successfully completed Cultural, Social and Technical Mathematics 414 and wish to bridge into Scientific and Technical Mathematics 506. This course is geared to students who need Scientific and Technical Mathematics 426 or Scientific Mathematics 426 as a prerequisite for entry into certain CEGEP programs.

Students **must** be recommended by their school administration.

Students may contact Summer School starting July 7, 2017 to confirm their secondary IV and V results. We encourage students to make sure they confirm their results to ensure that registration to courses and/or examination rewrites is done in time for summer programming.
