WALK FOR WATER

Last year, our Secondary 1 IB students and the Ambassadors for Change in the WE Club raised awareness and over \$1100.00 for the Chemagal community in Kenya to build a sanitation/latrine system. We are delighted to continue this tradition to support those who do not have access to clean drinking water and sanitation.

The aim of this activity is to enhance the students' understanding of global issues such as the need for access to clean water around the world through fundraising and symbolic action. The activity includes a walk to the Parc de la Cite lake where students will collect water in empty 2 - 4 litre containers and return with them to school, followed by reflection activities. Additional awareness activities are taking place during the lunch hour on behalf of the Ambassadors for Change in the WE club.



VOLUNTEER DAY

On a snowy April day, 61 individuals boarded two buses and traveled to 7 different charitable organizations for a day of volunteering. The teachers and students learned about what it means to care - to REALLY make a difference.

We interacted with special needs children, we walked and groomed abandoned pets, and we packed food boxes, and served meals to the homeless. No task was too big or too small because it was meaningful.
